The North Carolina Charter Educational Foundation establishes the following grading scales and policy for issuance of report cards.

A. Academic Grades

Kindergarten through 2nd* Grade:

Scale: E, S, N, U

E = Excellent (90---100)

S = Satisfactory (75---90)

N = Needs Improvement (65---74)

U = Unacceptable (0---64)

*Note: Second grade teachers will see E, S, N, or U in the gradebook, but percentages will appear on the student's report card.

Grades 3 - 8

Scale: A, B, C, D, F

A = 90 - - 100

B = 80 - - - 89

C = 70 - - 79

D = 60 - - 69

F = 0 - - 59

B. Citizenship Grades

The Citizenship Grade is comprised of three personal development skills: Conduct, Effort, and Participation.

Scale: E, S, N, U

E = Excellent

S = Satisfactory

N = Needs Improvement

U = Unacceptable



C. Report Card Distribution
