

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS ON THE BUS

Every student will be transported in the safest possible manner. In order to insure this, it is necessary for all students to meet certain behavior expectations and follow safe riding rules. Below are the HORNETS rules for riding a school bus. Please make sure your student understands the importance of these rules as they relate to the safety of everyone. The bus is an extension of the classroom and class conduct is expected.

Help *raise your hand or ask the driver if you need help*

Organized *bus loading and unloading*

Respect Bus rules and bus driver instructions

Noise Voice level of 1 or 2 and only talk to your seatmate

Eating No eating on the bus

Time Arrive 3-5 minutes early to the bus stop

Seated Properly Stay seated, facing forward, back on seat back, feet on floor
and out of the aisle

The use of personal electronic devices such as cell phones is allowed only with headphones. The taking of pictures is NOT allowed for any reason.

Violation of the bus rules may result in a transportation suspension or revocation of privileges.

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The undersigned persons acknowledge the school bus rules and understand that a student's riding privileges may be suspended or revoked for unsafe an/or inappropriate conduct.
