Emergency Health Care to Students

The district shall provide emergency health care which is reasonably necessary for the health of a student entrusted to the care of the district.

In a life-threatening situation, district staff will dial 911 for paramedic assistance and resuscitate any student requiring it in order to sustain life until relieved by paramedics or other appropriate medical personnel. The district values the contributions of all students to the overall success of all educational environments; therefore, no employee of the district shall comply with any parental request, written or verbal, for non-resuscitation of a student. Resuscitation means an attempt to restore life or consciousness after apparent death.
