GBB22. Use of Tobacco (Revised 10/07)

The District intends to be tobacco-free. Further, the District is concerned about the health of all District employees and also recognizes the importance of adult role modeling for students during the formative years. Therefore, the District shall promote non-smoking in school facilities and on school property, including outdoor areas, by employees, students, and citizens.

The use of tobacco products is prohibited within any building owned, leased, contracted for and utilized by the District for the provision of kindergarten, elementary, secondary education, or library services to children in accordance with 20 USC §6084 (The Pro-Children Act of 1994). This prohibition extends to any portion of a building that is routinely or regularly used by District employees and, therefore, prohibits the District from designating any area or room in a building as a smoking area. This prohibition also extends to all outdoor areas located on school property. The District shall not allow the use of tobacco products during staff and training meetings. Further, the District bans smoking and the use of tobacco products in all vehicles it owns or uses.
