Meeting Minutes

August 9, 2023

. Call to order

Mr. Hutch called to order the regular meeting of the MISD Livestock Committee at 6:32 PM on August 9, 2023.

II. Approval of minutes from last meeting

 - Mr. Hutch will order and call about shavings
 - We are ordering from who we ordered from in the past.
- c. Contact school for dumpster and electrical trees
 - Campbell is in charge of getting dumpsters and electrical trees
 - Went through Frank and Butch usually for electrical trees
- d. Bathrooms
 - i. Jim Ward has the bathrooms ready for show.
- e. Parking Lights
 - i. Campbell is going to work on this.
- f. Field for parking
 - i. Campbell is talking with the golf coach at Magnolia high school.
- g. Commemorative buckle
 - Mr. Hutch is in charge of this.
 - Moved and seconded that the commemorative buckle is dedicated to the John Shaffer scholarship foundation.
- h. Invitations and Posters
 - Territo brought them to the meeting for disbursement.
 - Add-on form, Auction form, and Post-Sale forms are already in for show.
- i. Hospitality Room -
 - MHS mom has done it in the past- Kathy Nance will be head of that maybe; Thomas and Waits will check on this.
 - Brandy Walker is willing to help with the hospitality room if need be.
- j. Buyer Bags
 - i. Brandy Walker is helping with filling these bags.

- ii. Riley has brought goodies to add to the buyer bags.
 - iii. Riley is sharing a form with the committee to send out to companies to see if there is anything else we can add to the bags.
- k. Show works subscription renewal
 - i. It was moved and seconded that we renew our show works subscription.
- l. Buckle Sponsors
 - Thomas is figuring out buckle sponsors for the three that were empty:
 - The ones missing are grand rabbit, reserve rabbit, and jr. showmanship steer.
 - Thomas is going to figure out if these buckles are for sure not taken yet and then figuring out how is going to cover which one.
 - The Ross's said they would pay for 2 buckle sponsorships if need be.
 - Reserve Rabbit was golden but he is out
 - Cassandra said no to sponsorship
 - Waits and Thomas ordered all buckles at state convention
- M. Buyer Gifts
 - Using the blankets from last year that did not get used because they arrived late.
- N. Past Champion banners & buckle/show sponsor banner
 - Tiffany is going to look into the banners
 - It was moved and seconded to give Waits control of researching and paying for our signs.
- O. Decorating the Auction Block
 - Boudreaux asking to have a budget to buy stuff to decorate
 - Waits has a checkered cloth, some sort of skirt to hand on the auction block.
 - Campbell says if we have enough cloth to decorate then do that if not give them a budget.
 - Waits moved that we give power to the subcommittee of Boudreaux and Waits not to exceed \$200 to decorate the auction block. If they can do it cheaper they will. It was moved and seconded.
 - It was later amended that we move the amount to \$300 so that they can buy silverware/plates for baked goods.

 - Ward and Hutch have talked to Buddy Adams about donating food again.
- Q. Show Set Up
 - Magnolia High Dads are bringing tractors again this year for set up.
 - Going to come up a week before to clean out old stuff
 - Campbell will bring in another dumpster if it is $\frac{3}{4}$ full already before the show.
- R. Lamb & Goat Trailer
 - Capps is going to call Jerry Kunetcka about this.
 - He said yes about coming and buying all lambs and goats.
- S. Rabbits Trailer
 - Heaton said that he will buy back the extra bunnies at \$10 a head.
 - Lawrence is our back up plan if Heaton does not show up.
- T. Other Info
 - We need to assign someone to set weight classes in the September meeting.

- We need to make sure to buy water for the hospitality room this year. One of the Magnolia High dads is doing this. Last year we had 8 cases (24 packs) and we ran out. Maybe get 15 cases. He will buy it and we will reimburse them.

U. Baked Goods Room & Buyers Dinner

- We need plates and forks for a buyer's dinner.
- We need plates, forks, spoons, for the Judge in the baked goods room.
- Boudreaux is going to buy silverware for the judge in the room and buyers dinner.
