It feels just like yesterday that students and staff left for summer break. But now, the excitement of a new school year is just around the corner. The signs are all around: Football, marching band, soccer, volleyball, flag corps, tennis, and cross country have all been practicing for the Fall Season. Our custodians and buildings and grounds staff have worked hard preparing our schools for a new year, and teachers have been getting their classrooms ready. We cannot wait for our first day of school on August 16th! Below are some of the programs and upgrades we wanted to highlight for the 2023-24 school year:

A. Bus Safety Awareness Campaign: "Stop on Red, Kids Ahead!"
Last year, River Valley buses experienced over 100 "red light runners" incidents when a vehicle passed a bus with red lights flashing and stopped
to pick up or drop off a student. River Valley Bus Driver, Heather Demorest,
experienced a close call one morning two years ago when one of her
students was nearly hit by an oncoming vehicle that did not stop when she
was stopped with her red lights flashing. Her experience led to this
campaign to raise awareness of the need for vehicles to stop when buses
have red lights flashing. Please help us to spread the word and protect our
children: "Stop on Red, Kids Ahead!"

B. All Heritage and Liberty Students Qualify for Free Breakfast this Year Each morning, every student at our elementary schools will be able to have free breakfast in their classroom as an expansion of the opportunity that has been available over the past few for our Liberty students.

C. USDA Farm to School Grant

River Valley Schools was one of only five schools in the state of Ohio to receive this grant. This grant allows for more opportunities to expand our RV Farm area and to grow fresh produce that can be used by our food service in meals for our students. This will also allow for our Biology, Agricultural Science, and FFA students to have more hands-on learning opportunities.



D. Building Safety Upgrades

Over the next couple of months we will be highlighting the various improvements to our buildings as part of the State of Ohio Safety Grants. Each of our four buildings received the maximum \$100,000 from the state grants. Stay turned for more information.

Welcome to the '23-'24 school year!! Bus routes can be viewed on the RV website under Transportation (rvk12.org/bus). All open enrollment students will not have transportation for the first two weeks of school. Please make sure FinalForms are updated, indicating your student(s) needs transportation and the address is correct. Please contact Trista Thorpe at 740-725-5410 to sign your student up for open enrollment busing. This is on a first-come, first-served basis. Open enrollment students will be able to start riding a bus on August 29th.

There will be buses at the elementary Open House again this year. Kindergarten students are encouraged to stop and learn how to load/unload a bus and practice an emergency bus evacuation. All students will be given a flyer with information on loading/unloading a bus and rules for the bus. Parents are encouraged to go over these rules and procedures with the students.



As we prepare to begin the 2023-2024 school year, we are examining vaccination documentation for our students. The State of Ohio mandates that students have an updated vaccination record or a valid vaccination waiver on file to attend a public school.

As time goes by and booster shots are recommended, it becomes crucial for us to review our records to ensure the health and safety of all our students. If your child is entering Kindergarten, 7th grade, or 12th grade, I kindly ask you to consult with your physician to confirm your child's vaccinations are up-to-date.

To comply with state regulations, please submit an updated copy of your child's vaccination record or a vaccination waiver to the school office or upload it through FinalForms before October 1st. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated, and we eagerly anticipate a safe and healthy school year.

News from the Food Service Team

Even though we aren't serving meals in our cafeterias during summer break, it has been a busy one for The Lunch Bunch.







The Lunch Bunch Food Truck has made its way to several community events this summer. The Lunch Bunch continues to grow and serve our communities. We have built a new partnership with the Morrow County Seniors on Center to provide meals for the Morrow County Meals on Wheels program. Even though this service has just begun a few weeks ago, we have learned valuable lessons on recipes and nutrition that will prove helpful in our school cafeterias. Again, revenue generated from this will go directly into our food service program for our students.



Our farm program continues progressing, with the installation of our high tunnel completed at the end of June. Shortly after, on July 21, 2023, it was announced that River Valley Schools Food Service Department was awarded \$100,000 from the Patrick Leahy Farm to School Program. River Valley's Food Service Department was one of five programs selected by the USDA to be awarded in 2023 in Ohio. We currently have a variety of vegetables growing in our outdoor space and look forward to more learning opportunities for our students. Visit rvk12.org/farmtoschool for more information.

Treasurer's Talk

The May five-year forecast reflects the reality of River Valley Local School District's financial situation over the course of the next five years. Despite additional anticipated funding passed in HB33, the state biennium budget for the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 school years, our District is still expected to have a significant revenue shortfall due to current levy terms expiring during the forecast. As many of you know, the two levies placed on the ballot in the May 2, 2023 special election did not pass. After listening to members of our community over the last several months the Board needed to weigh both the needs of the District and the feedback received from the community before deciding what the next steps forward would be. In response, the District will be placing two issues on the November 7, 2023 ballot, as well as making financial changes beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.

The two issues being placed on the ballot by the Board are similar to what was on the ballot in May 2023, but with modifications in terms for both levies, as well as the dollar amount for the bond, based on the feedback that was received from the community. The first issue that will be on the ballot will be a Bond+Permanent Improvement (PI) combination levy. The bond component of the issue will be a 20-year bond for \$10M, a reduction in term from 25-years to 20-years and a reduction in the dollar amount from \$21.1M to \$10M; the PI component of the issue will be a 5-year, 2.5 mill PI levy, a reduction in term from continuing to 5-years. The second issue that will be on the ballot will be the Earned Income Tax Renewal. The income tax renewal will be the same 1% of earned income as is currently in place for a term of 5 years, a reduction from the 20-year term proposed in May.

In addition to the levies that will be on the ballot in November, the Board of Education has implemented some changes for the 2023-2024 school year to save money and assist with our financial situation. While these changes will help, the need for additional changes if the levies do not pass in November remains. The changes being made during 2023-2024 include: reducing open enrollment numbers, 5% reduction in building supply budgets, elimination of the District's virtual school, no parking lot improvements, and nine positions not filled following staff resignations.

We appreciate and value the feedback from our community over the last several months. However, the reality is that the needs of our District have not changed, which is why we decided to continue forward with the two issues we had in May, but with the modifications outlined above. We have building projects that still need to be addressed, such as roofs, HVAC, and parking lots, along with the continued goal to provide our students a quality education and be a valuable resource to our community.
