## New on Monday: Arrival Time Ends 8:00 AM

Monday, 8/14, we will begin our standard arrival schedule. Arrival will continue to begin at 7:40 AM and will end at 8:00 AM. ### 23-24 Daily Arrival & Dismissal Reminders

- All same-day transportation changes must be made in School Pass (preferred) or by calling the front desk by 1:30 PM.
- Scholars not picked up from HPA by 3:30 PM are considered "late pick-up." All late pick-ups will be sent to BRAVE and subject to their fees:
  - \$10/scholar picked up before 4:00 PM
  - o \$17/scholar picked up after 4:00 PM
