Football Game Expectations for Middle/Elementary School Students

Middle School Section: (Location)

All students will be on the North (home) side of Collins Field

Located East of the Press Box...on the hilltop behind main grandstand

Students are required to have a parent or guardian upon entry to the game. Parents/Guardians are also expected to stay for the duration of the game.

Behavior expectations:

Be a spectator, be respectful of the game, fans and staff

Seated on bleachers and/or tables or stand on the grass area provided

Promote positive cheer support for the Stoughton Vikings "We are Stoughton"

No footballs, soccer balls, etc. or games in general are not acceptable

Running, tag games, wrestling, etc. are also not acceptable

Students are not allowed wandering throughout The Anderson Complex. They should remain on the Home side unless they are leaving the event.

Benefits:

Students will have a designated area on home sideline that will have designated MS seating

Students can see the scoreboard, have access to concessions/bathrooms and a better connection of the game as being part of the home crowd

Promotes a more polished public image of the Stoughton Community and provides safety of our students
