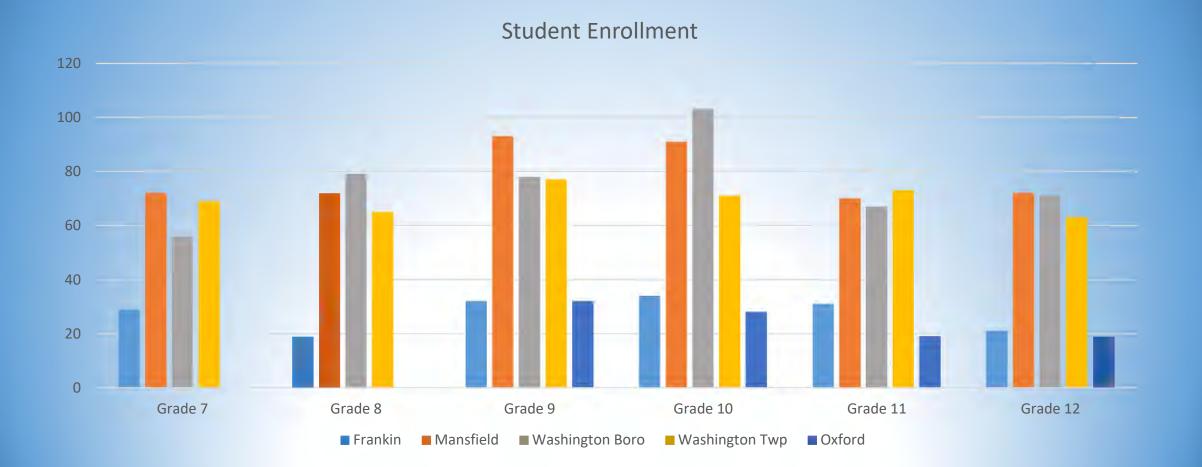

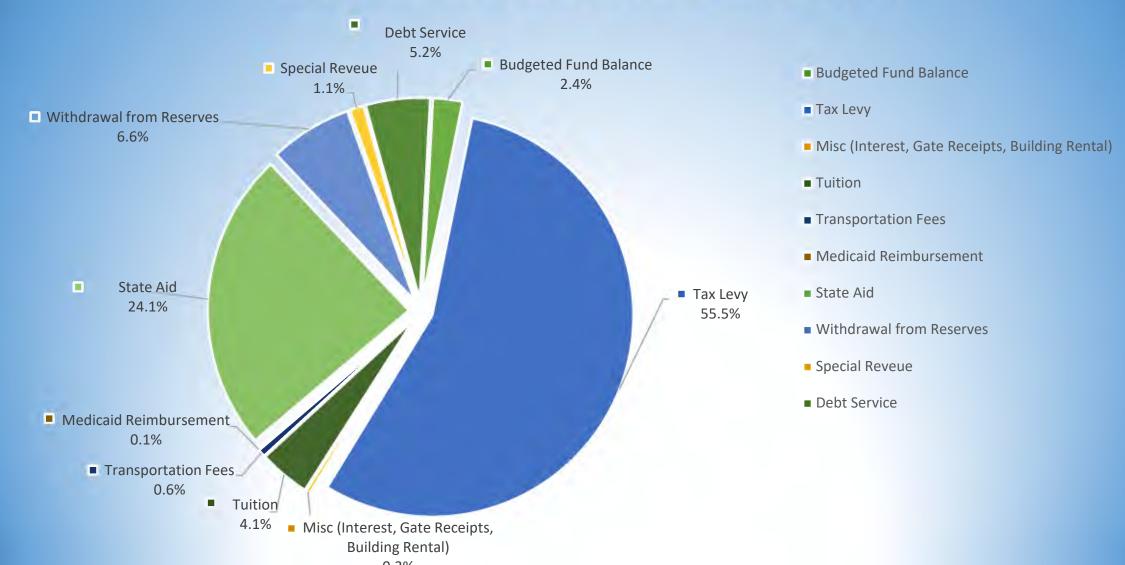
Cost Savings & Shared Services

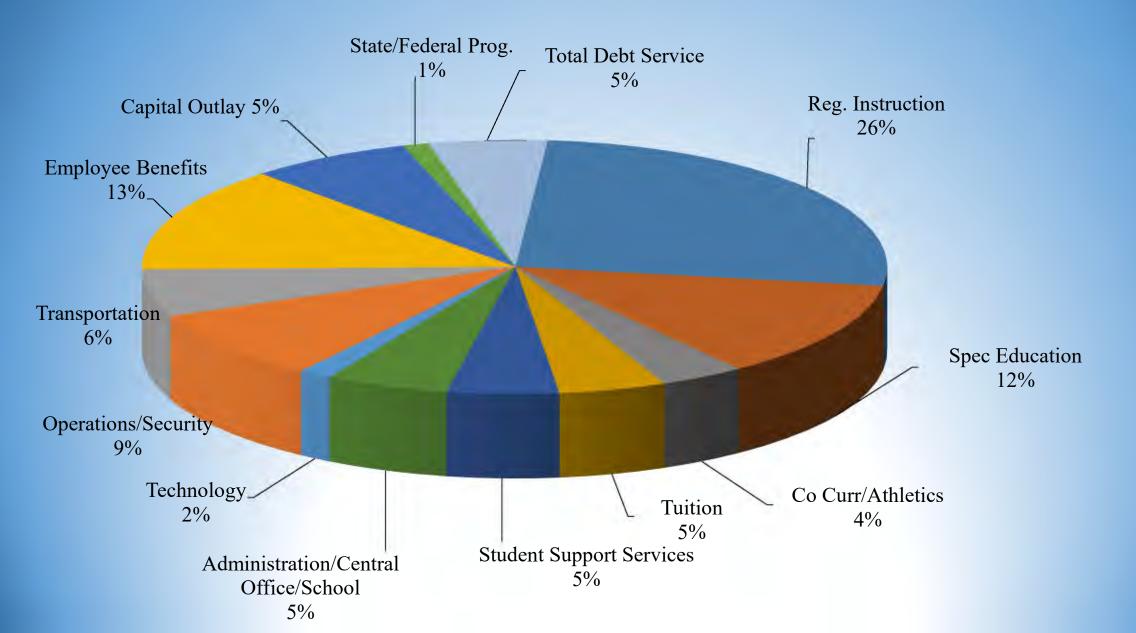
Where does the money come from? 2022-2023 REVENUE



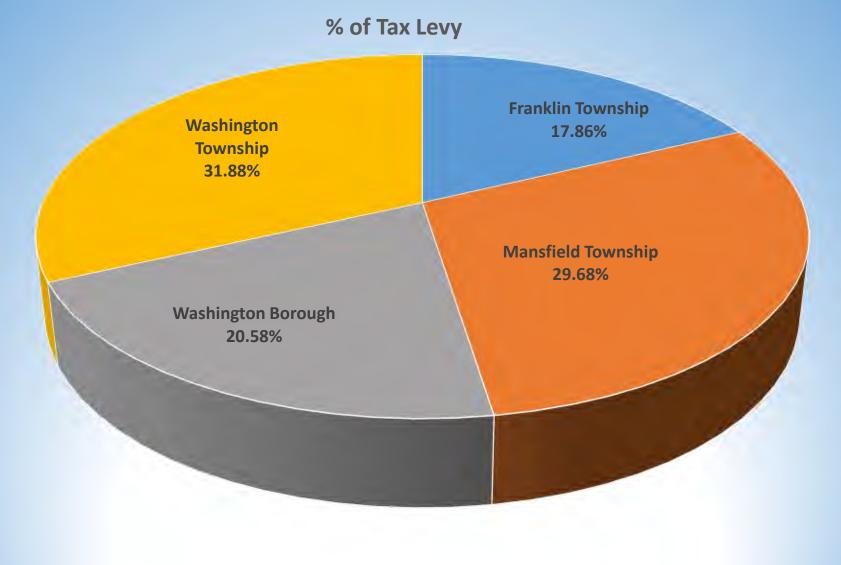
STATE AID HISTORY
