Dr. Mark Daniel, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

RECOMMENDATION: Croninger Elementary School has been selected to be a recipient of the prestigious National Blue Ribbon Schools award by the U.S. Department of Education. This award recognizes schools with the highest achieving students in English/language arts and mathematics as measured by state assessments.

RELATED INFORMATION: Croninger is the only school in the area, one of only ten schools in Indiana, and one of the 297 schools across the country, to receive this honor. According to Dr. Katie Jenner, Indiana Secretary of Education “Our Indiana Blue Ribbon Schools are consistently raising the bar year after year, with a keen focus on moving the needle for all students.”

Public Hearing on the 2023 Budgets, Capital Projects Plan and the School Bus Replacement

Dr. Daniel presented the following recommendation concerning the Public Hearing on the 2023 Budgets, Capital Projects Plan and the School Bus Replacement Plan:

A public budget presentation was made at the September 12, 2022, Board of School Trustees meeting. All Board adopted funds and proposed budgets were discussed, and estimated tax rates were reviewed. The notice for the Capital Projects Plan and the Bus Replacement Plan were properly advertised on September 12, 2022 on Indiana Gateway and the FWCS website.

According to Indiana law, the school corporation must conduct a public hearing on the budgets, the three-year Capital Projects Plan and five years of the Bus Replacement Plan. A hearing is scheduled for this evening’s meeting of the Board of School Trustees. The intent of the hearing is to allow Board members the opportunity to receive community input. Board members will be asked to vote on these items on October 10, 2022.

This was the appropriate time for members of the public to address the Board regarding the 2023 budgets, the 2023-2025 Capital Projects Plan and the 2023-2027 School Bus Replacement Plan. No one came before the Board to speak.

Comments

Board Member Steve Corona just found out that that former Congressman Mark Souder passed away today. Member Corona thanked the over 400 students and adults who attended the Latinos Count luncheon last week which included 250 middle school students. Sixteen \$1,000 scholarships were awarded. Board Member Jennifer Matthias also spoke on the data concerning the Blue Ribbon award. She stated that seven out of the ten Indiana schools are public schools, which is a shift from past years. It is a big pat on the back for Croninger. She also mentioned that Croninger’s practicing for the Jungle Book was all done after school

Board Member Maria Norman was able to attend Croninger’s production of the Jungle Book in partnership with Montana’s Missoula Children's Theatre. Vice President Norman was amazed that in five days the students were able to put on this production. She is proud of the staff and students for putting on this opportunity and was thankful for the invitation.

Board Member Rohli Booker was also impressed with Croninger’s Jungle Book theatre production in that short amount of time. Secretary Booker stated that it was a testament to the staff, students and parents. Ms. Booker also did a shout out to Abbett’s 3rd class and the rest of the Wolfpacks.

Board Member Noah Smith also commented about Croninger’s Jungle Book production, that it was remarkable the K-5th grade students, took it to heart, and didn’t miss a line or action.



Board President Anne Duff also congratulated Croninger.


