RECOMMENDATION: It was recommended that the Board accepts the donation of \$10,000 to Weisser Park STEAM Magnet Elementary School from Subaru Loves Learning for classroom teachers to purchase STEAM materials for their classrooms to encourage STEAM education.

RELATED INFORMATION: "Adopt a Classroom" is a national organization that partners with various companies that are committed to supporting education in the communities where they do business. One of their partners, Fort Wayne Subaru, has chosen to fund teachers at Weisser Park because of their focus on STEAM education. In the past four years, Weisser Park has transitioned from a fine arts magnet school to a STEAM magnet school integrating science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics in its core instruction.

Dave Moser at Fort Wayne Subaru will visit Weisser Park to present the money to 5th graders during an assembly. He will talk to them about community and how we help our community.

Early Intervention Grant, 2022-23

RELATED INFORMATION: The Early Intervention Grant (EIG) is used to improve early literacy through intervention programming. EIG provides funding for research-based programming to increase student achievement of literacy in grades K-2.

Pay Increases for Substitutes

RECOMMENDATION: It was recommended that the Board approve three changes to pay for substitute teachers.

RELATED INFORMATION: The changes to substitute teacher pay are designed to attract more candidates to fill this important role and retain current substitute teachers. The changes are as follows:

- Licensed Substitutes - Current pay \$120 per day; increased to \$150 per day
- Long Term Substitutes without teaching license - Current pay \$150 per day; increased to \$170 per day, beginning day 16
- Licensed FWCS Retirees - Current pay \$150 per day; increased to \$170 per day

Secondly, last week he was a part of a meeting with IDOE’s State Superintendent Katie Jenner and Commissioner Lowery where they spoke on the automatic enrollment of 21st Century Scholars. Finally, Mr. Corona spoke that was the guest speaker earlier today at North Side for Jobs for American Graduate, and saw Dave West with a broom completing the “other duties as assigned” role.

Board Member Julie Hollingsworth spoke about her first day of school visits at Indiana Village and Maplewood. Recently she spoke to some FWCS staff about the start of the school year and they replied it was “so much better than last year” as we are getting back to normal. She also visited Wayne and was impressed how the school is functioning amidst the construction. Lastly, she visited the FW Virtual Academy, and was able to see how the set schedule was working, we’ve definitely learned a lot over the pandemic. Member Hollingsworth also spoke about a grandparent whose grandchild enrolled at a competitor virtual school and the need for FWCS to market our academy.

Board Member Jennifer Matthias first day of school visits included Haley and Washington Center elementary schools. She enjoyed visiting a school she had never been to before. Member Matthias also spoke about last Friday’s Ideal Graduate meeting where students who spoke were amazing. It reinforces

that everything we do is for the students. She thanked the Community and Dr. Daniel for making the district better.

Board Member Rohli Booker visited South Side, Harrison Hill, Irwin and Portage on the first day of school. Ms. Booker did a shout out to staff who did registration on the first day. Today she saw the sign “Drive like your kid lives here” which made her think how the Fort Wayne community rallies together. Member Booker also spoke about the proposed jail that is in very close proximity to East Allen County schools, she implored listeners to learn more, advocate and a learn more through the resource, Help Not Handcuffs organization.

Board Member Noah Smith did a first day of school to visit at Blackhawk and Croninger, along with visiting Glenwood and Amp Lab. He thanked parents for trusting their students with us.

Superintendent Dr. Mark Daniel also had first day visits at Jefferson, Haley and Amp Lab. He was also able to visit the first 3DE program in Indiana at Snider and North Side. The Superintendent spoke about the focus on Literacy grant and the amount of elementary teachers who committed to OG over the summer with no cost to FWCS. This school year we will start to examine numeracy, as early as possible, by having teachers in the planning stages, not just the implementation. Well-being is also a priority, a concern even with legislators across the state. Need to ensure a learning environment, to move us to another level in educating our kids. Would like to flexibility in high school diploma, increase dual credits, steer into livable wages pipelines. Dr. Daniel also mentioned today’s Work Session on Transportation, which is a complex problem, want to transport students safely and arrive in a timely fashion. Kuddos to Transportation Department who continue to work weekends. We appreciate patience with parents and educators as we continue to work on Transportation.

Board President Anne Duff spoke about her first day visits to Lakeside, South Wayne and North Side. President Duff also spoke about last weekend’s Indiana Coalition of Public Education, and her speaking on winning the fight of the proposed Charter School.






