A. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- a. South Washington County Schools is planning a bond election to be held November 7, 2023.
- b. Two questions will be on the ballot concerning school facilities.
- c. The first question centers on expansions and renovations at the secondary schools. The second question centers on expanding 4 elementary schools which are projected to go over capacity.
- d. If the second question does not pass, school boundary changes will be required to balance out the enrollment of the schools going over capacity.
- e. A school boundary plan has been drafted to provide information to district voters during the bond election information campaign.
- f. The School Board will be presented with the draft plan.
