Dress Code Policy

STUDENTS WHO ARE DRESS CODED WILL BE PROVIDED CLOTHING FROM OUR CLOTHING PANTRY.

1. Students are expected to follow the Montera Dress Code Policy daily.
2. Montera Dress Code Policy is effective 1 week after school resumes (8/14/23).
3. Students who are dress coded will be given temporary clothing from the clothing pantry.
4. If dress code corrections are unavailable (i.e. student refusing to change into temporary clothing, guardian unable to bring a change of clothes) students may be given a temporary work space with their grade level admin/support.

Dress Code expectations and redirections are listed below.

1st non-dress code	dress code warning and temporary clothing provided from clothing pantry
2nd non-dress code	phone call home, temporary clothing provided
3⁺ non-dress code	phone call home, temporary clothing provided, dress code referral log



- NO PJ's or Blankets.
- NO grills (teeth).
- NO clothing with inappropriate writing or logos (drugs, weapons, alcohol).
- NO ripped jeans or clothing with holes in it without leggings underneath.
- NO revealing tops or bottoms including see through clothing.
- NO sagging jeans, pants, shorts, or skirts.
- NO slides, slippers, flip flops, backless footwear.
