Lessons Learned

Play Yard

- Used for lunch time recess, PE, after school programs and sports during and after school. Some play space is needed during construction but also a goal to not stretch construction out too long so recognition that some sacrifice on space will help
- Garden to be accommodated on yard
- Adjacent Park cannot be utilized during construction

Phasing

- Phasing of Building A construction seems possible pending confirmation by DSA
- Clinic remaining in place during Construction seems possible, but an extended summer shut down would be needed
- Reducing overall construction duration important goal

Interim Housing

- Library to be accommodate in 1 portable classroom during construction
- District typically provides Music, Science, Art standard size classrooms during construction
- Likely do not need temporary clinic
- Temporary Facilities for Administration and Student Support in Development

Lessons Learned

Building A

- Clinic would remain in current location 'as is' minus structural work
- Right Sizing of Classrooms is a priority
- Library space remains 'as is'

Administration

• Main Administration to remain in building A in middle of campus with new accessible 'front door' for safe secure entry through Admin during school day

Gym

- Not used during lunch, hosts rainy day lunch recess, cannot be used for
- Not able to accommodate lunch recess or all sports programs

New Cafeteria

Reduced in size. Accommodates lunch by 1/3 of school at a time (as opposed to ¹/₂)

6th Grade Cluster

 Ideally the group of classrooms created through the project serves the full 6th grade program

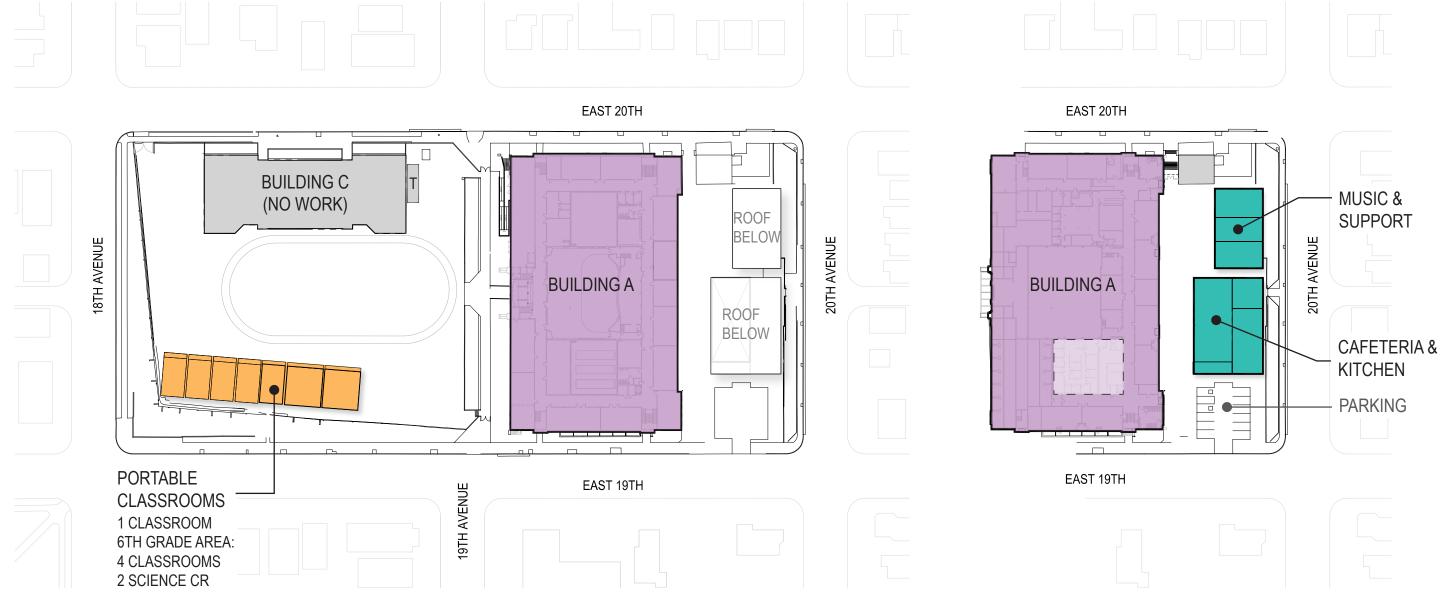
