

#### INTERIM TERM

Interim Term, launched in January 2026, is an abbreviated academic session that takes place between the fall and spring semesters. It offers students the opportunity to pursue enriching, non-traditional learning experiences outside the standard classroom format. Offerings during Interim Term may include:

- Project-based learning
- Domestic and international travel
- Service learning
- Career development and internships

This focused term allows students to explore new interests, gain hands-on experience, and deepen their learning in meaningful and creative ways.

#### DISCIPLINE

Serious student misconduct in grades 10-12 involving physical or psychological harm, repeated matters of integrity, or unlawful activity will be self-reported by students in consultation with their college counselor and in accordance with questions on college applications.

## **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

A total of 22 credits are required for graduation, including 3 credits of elective.

Students in grades 9 and 10 take six courses for credit each year. Students in grades 11 and 12 must take a minimum of five courses for credit each year. There is no community service requirement for graduation.

## **GRADING SCALE**

Enrollment in Honors/AP is determined by department approval and requires a B+ minimum in prerequisite courses. Students do not generally take AP courses until junior year. Weighted GPA adds 0.5 for AP courses and 0.33 for Honors courses.






