This alternative education school was made possible by the 2018 Bond passed by Douglas County voters.



Douglas County School District Funding Needs in Parker

When Home Values Go Up Does School Funding Automatically Increase? An increase in local funding due to economic growth and rising property taxes does **NOT** provide our schools with more money, it just means the state contributes less.

Mill Levy Overrides (MLO)

Each school district can request additional local funding through a local Mill Levy Override (MLO). This funding is generally used for operations, including salaries, staffing, and student programming. A potential 2023 MLO for the Douglas County School District would provide teachers and staff in every Parker public school (neighborhood and charter) with more competitive pay and would provide more security (including School Resource Officers) in Parker schools.



*MLO per student is total MLO divided by funded pupil count; Average teacher salaries are from CDE data for the 2021-2022 school year.

Per Colorado Department of Education, Douglas County School District's General Administration Spending Per Student is \$63 vs. \$149 in Littleton Public Schools and \$189 in Denver Public Schools.

Bonds

Local voter-approved general obligation bonds are used by school districts for capital needs such as constructing new school buildings or additions to existing school buildings, facility repairs and upgrades, security upgrades, classroom equipment, buses, and technology.

How Parker Schools Would Benefit from Additional Funding
