WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?



Dual enrollment refers to students being enrolled, concurrently, in two educational institutions. While our students are taking classes at DePaul Catholic, they pay the University (Seton Hall or Caldwell University) a fee, and as long as they meet the minimum requirements, they will be awarded the opportunity to earn college credits before they officially begin college.
