

BOARD MEMBERSHIP - ELECTIONS

Code **BBB** Issued **12/21**

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for election to the board.

The board is composed of nine members who reside within the boundaries of the district.

Board members must be elected by the qualified electors of the district in a nonpartisan election held in odd-numbered years.

The regular term of office for each trustee is four years. All terms of office will begin at the December meeting following the election in which a member is elected.
