Plant – Based Coach

The Plant-Based Coach is a stipend (\$300) position that will help promote, support, and build awareness of whole food, plant-based (WFPB) nutrition. The Plant-Based Coach will be the go to resource to encourage and help individuals realize the health benefits of eating a more plant centric diet.

REPORTS TO:

Works in conjunction with the district health and wellness coordinator and Sweet Pea dietitians.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

The specific duties of the plant-based coach will include but not limited to:

- Plan and facilitate activities that will share plant-based nutrition benefits and recipes.
- In cooperation with the Health and Wellness coordinator assist staff who participate in The Good Life Challenge or 10-Day Challenge
- If possible, develop a small lending library using FLASHP funds to help expand staff knowledge in plant-based nutrition (see recommended books)
- Coach individuals on transitioning and finding balance as they shift to WFPB
- Refer individuals needing additional attention to a dietitian, physician, and/or healthcare Provider

- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Experience and knowledge of whole food, plant-based nutrition
