The North Rose-Wolcott Central School District is seeking candidates for the following anticipated position for 2023-24 school year:

Healthy Rewards Ambassador

The Healthy Rewards Ambassador (HRA) position's primary goal is to be a resource to those in each district who have Healthy Blue insurance. Employees and their spouses with Healthy Blue policies are eligible to enroll and participate in Rally Healthy Rewards.

The yearly stipend for this position is \$300. Some districts have (2) two or more ambassadors who share the duties and the stipend.

The primary qualification to be a HRA is being an experienced and regular user of the Rally online program. Once identified by the district wellness coordinator, the HRA attends a training session with the Smola Consulting Wellness Consultant (SCWC).

The main goal of the training is to identify the many ways that the HRA can choose from to help eligible district employees access and earn their \$500 Rally Rewards.

Methods that are encouraged include but are not limited to:

1. Be accessible to answer routine questions that arise on a day-to-day basis
2. Offer small group or one on one training sessions for all employee groups on a regular basis in a variety of ways and settings. Creativity is encouraged.
3. Workshops on conference days

HRA are encouraged to make a special effort to reach out to those employees who may have challenges with technology.

Another responsibility of the HRA is to be the conduit of information from the SCWC. Periodically, the SCWC will send new information, reports, updates or problem-solving information to the HRA. Sharing this information with eligible employees in a timely manner is important.
