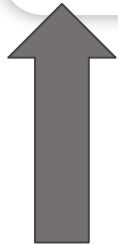

Improves Driving Skills



Driver's Education

- Increases student safety and confidence behind the wheel
- Teaches driving etiquette
- Provides driving experience
- Reduces recklessness
- Identifies and corrects bad habits and can help improve specific driving skills such as braking, stopping, turning, parallel parking, and merging

Earn MV-285

The New York State Education Department (NYSED) approves the Driver Education courses for students in high schools and colleges. If you complete a driver education course through a high school or a college, you will receive a **Student Certificate of Completion** (form MV-285). This certificate is valid for two years.

All insurance companies are different. Some insurance companies may offer discounts for students that earn their MV-285 (student certificate of completion of NYS Driver's Education Course).

Get your MV-278 (5 hour course)



A Pre-Licensing Course Completion

Certificate (also known as Form MV-278) is a certificate issued by: (a) a commercial driving school, secondary school (high school or BOCES) or college to an individual who has taken a DMV-approved Pre-Licensing Course; or (b) by a secondary school or college to an individual who has completed sufficient classroom instruction through a Driver's Education program. These certificates enable the recipients to schedule a road test with the DMV.



Receive .5 credit

To successfully complete Driver's Education, students must pass with at least a 65 in both theory and laboratory (car).

Mock Test for DMV



Before the conclusion of Driver's Education, students will go through a series of drills that are similar to the NY State DMV Driver's Test.

Instructor feedback will mimic the NYS DMV Examination.
