


## Athletes and Coaches of 1963—1964

The athletes and coaches of 1963-1964 contributed to one of the most memorable years of athletic accomplishments in the history of Dansville Athletics. The combined record of all athletic teams was 117 wins and 17 losses (a winning percentage of .873). During this year, 4 titles were won: the varsity football team won the Livingston County Championship; the varsity basketball team won the County Title; the varsity wrestling team was undefeated and won the Conference Title and, in the spring, the track team won the County Meet. An article in the local paper at the time summarized this memorable year: "...athletes with top-flight athletic ability were available and the coaches were well educated in the art of directing and teaching the athletes in the finer arts of various physical contests".



Don earned 8 Varsity Letters during his time as an athlete at DHS. During his senior year of varsity football, he averaged 10 yards per carry and was a leader on the defense. In basketball, Don was a starting point guard for 2 years. In spring competition, he earned 2 Varsity D's in track during his freshman and sophomore years, finishing 3rd in hurdles at the County Meet. Don switched to playing baseball during his junior and senior years.


During his playing days at DHS, Jim earned his Varsity D in football, wrestling and baseball. In football, Jim was selected as an All-League Linebacker (junior & senior year) and All-League Running Back (senior year). Jim received the Doc Conway Defensive Player Award, was selected as the Team MVP, and, as of this induction, holds the school record for tackles in a season (127 tackles, 15.7 tackles per game). In wrestling, Jim earned the Sam Cappadonia Most Outstanding Wrestler in the County Award, was a County Champion (junior and senior year), All-County Selection (junior and senior year), earned a 2nd place finish in Sectionals and a semi-final finish at State Qualifiers. Jim was a Genesee Valley Tournament Champion (senior year), Team MVP (senior year), and held an undefeated record in duel meets (senior year). In baseball, Jim received All-County recognition. Jim's accomplishments earned him the honor of receiving the John Nelson Award for Senior Male Athlete of the Year at DHS.

## **TERRY CONWAY**

At the time of this induction, Terry is 2nd all time for most tackles by a defensive lineman. After graduating from DHS, Terry played 4 years of Division I Football at Colgate University. In his senior year at DHS, Terry was a member of the varsity wrestling team and earned 1st Place at the Section V - Class A wrestling qualifiers, eventually finishing in 4th Place at State Qualifiers. In the years since, Terry has become "Coach Conway" thanks to his 30+ years of coaching both football and track at DHS.
