Understanding the Scholarships & Awards

1. **Deadline Date** = when the application and any other required documents are due.
2. **Scholarship/Award** = the name of the scholarship, award or program, along with any website that you may need to visit in order to apply
3. **Amount** = the number of awards that are available and the value of each award.
4. **Requirements** = the criteria required to apply. This is a quick reference to determine if you meet all of the requirements and should continue with the application process.
5. **Bold red lettered opportunities** are local scholarships/awards that will be recognized at the Senior Awards Ceremony at the end of the school year. These are opportunities from the many generous donors in our community.
6. **Bold purple lettered opportunities** are regional scholarships/awards. These are opportunities that are advertised through various websites from organizations that are often within the 8-County region (Monroe, Ontario, Wayne, Genesee, Livingston, Orleans, Seneca, and Yates.)
7. Normal black letter typed opportunities are national-level scholarships/awards. These may include scholarships, awards, and/or programs that are on a national level. Sometimes, these opportunities have been forwarded to the Counseling Office or we have become aware of them through other searches.
8. **Yellow Highlighted opportunities** are any new scholarships/awards that have been added to a newly posted flier listing. This makes it easy to locate any new opportunities that haven't appeared on earlier lists.
9. Hard copies (or fliers with details/information) of applications may be found in the scholarship boxes located in the Counseling Office and are filed in order by deadline date; the soonest deadline date will be at the front of the box with the farthest deadline date at the back of the box. For opportunities that say you need to apply online, visit the website that is listed under the scholarship/award title.
10. For all local scholarships/awards, you must write your name and the date you are picking up an application on the sign-out sheet that will be in the front of each folder containing applications. It is **very important** that you remember to complete this step, as many donating organizations ask for this information before selecting a recipient.
11. **NOTE:** The Scholarships & Awards flier that is posted from the Counseling Office **does not** contain the only available opportunities!!! Please remember to search for other opportunities via the internet, as well as search the college/university that you will be applying to or attending. There are MILLIONS of dollars of FREE MONEY waiting to be claimed ... If you don't apply for any of it, then you won't be selected to receive any of it.
