Office of Student Services

Credits versus grade pass (36 common core, 16 elective)

Required for graduation

Math (8), English (8), Science (6), Social Studies (6), World Languages (4), Art, (2), PE/Health (2)

Elective Credits: (16) in various classes

How many credits a student earns every 6 weeks per class?

$\frac{1}{2}$ credit per class ($.5 \times 5$ classes = 2.5 credits every 6 weeks)

Trimester versus marking periods

Trimester (12 weeks) long earning 5 credits/trimester \times 3 trimesters = 15 credits/year

Marking periods (6 weeks) long earning 2.5/marketing period \times 6 marking periods 15 credits/year

How does the E20 Lab and E20 classes work?

To earn credits in the E20 lab, a student needs to progress at a 17% progress per week

Earning Extra Credit

Extra E20 classes will be immediately assigned as a student finishes an E20 class early

Community Service Hours (every 30 hours = $\frac{1}{2}$ credit)

Credits from a job (copy of paystubs, minimum of 10 hours/week, pass 3 out of 5 classes)

Credits from the SAT test in English and Math (score of 450 or higher in each)

Weekly phone call to home discussing progress or lack of (need contact info)

Upperclassmen programs (classes offered and programs beyond the HS)

Jackson College Early College 13th year (enrolled by Sophomore status)

Michigan Works Career Readiness (3 levels of classes)
