- The ability to teach and demonstrate the SOAR expectations to our students and members of our community.
- Good citizenship and have positive relationships with others.
- A strong work ethic, completes classroom and homework assignments .
- Excellent attendance (on time with limited absences and early check outs).

Students must complete the application and have a parent and two staff members sign the application.

QUALIFICATIONS TO STAY ON THE STUDENT LEADERSHIP TEAM

The Student Leadership Team Members have a lot of responsibility throughout the year. It is imperative that they have outstanding attendance, wonderful character, and learn the essential outcomes for each subject.

- Each quarter the Student Leadership Members' grades will be reviewed. Students should have positive work habits and behavior.
- Students should have excellent attendance.
- Students must attend ALL Student Leadership Team Meetings. After two unexcused absences, the student will no longer be on the team.
