

## Bylaws of the Board

### Duties of Members

Board of Education authority as the duly constituted governing body of the school district can be translated into action only through motions adopted or passed at official meetings of the Board of Education or by Board of Education members acting with special responsibility delegated by the Board of Education. The Board of Education as a body exists only at Board of Education meetings, and members authority exists only at Board of Education meetings or when discharging a Board of Education assignment.
