

Bylaws of the Board

Members (Eligibility, Representation, Attendance)

Board of Education members are elected by the voters of Marlborough to represent the best interests of all children, families and citizens in their policy deliberation and decision making. As such, Board members are expected to attend and participate in all Board meetings. It is understood that there may be extenuating circumstances which may be cause for an infrequent absence but that should be the rare exception. Board members who are not present cannot contribute to the important decisions of the Board and, as such, fail to represent the duties for which they have been elected. Board members who find that work, family or health issues prevent regular attendance and participation in Board policy and budget decisions and therefore cannot fully represent children, families, citizens and voters should responsibly resign from the Board in a timely manner and allow the appointment of a new Board member to serve the community.
