

Bylaws of the Board

Filling Vacancies

Any vacancy on the Board of Education, from whatever cause arising, shall be filled by appointment by the Board of Selectmen for the balance of the term for which the person vacating the office had been elected. In the case of comparable qualifications of affiliated and unaffiliated candidates, candidates affiliated with the party from which the vacancy occurred, shall have priority.

Board member resignations shall be submitted in writing to the Board Chair and upon receipt, the Board Chair will notify the full Board. The resignation will be reported at the next regular Board meeting.

The Chairperson of the Board of Education shall immediately notify the Town Clerk and the Chairperson of the appropriate political party of any vacancies on the Board of Education.
