2024-25 BCTC Transportation Guidelines

Although we try our best to communicate each BCTC transportation scenario, situations do occur which may require us to modify our guidelines. As such, each parent and BCTC student will receive specific instructions the day before and/or the day of each situation noted below.

Governor Mifflin High School students attending BCTC will attend the morning session only. **Governor Mifflin School District will transport the BCTC students to and from the East and West Career Centers.** All GMSD buses will depart the high school **promptly at 7:25 a.m.**; students must arrive five minutes earlier. Students will return to GMHS at approximately 10:50 a.m. – students at BCTC East will depart at 10:20 a.m.; students at BCTC West will depart at 10:25 a.m. BCTC students will have their **lunch period at GMHS.**

Due to the fluctuation between the school calendars, the following transportation parameters will be in place for this school year:

- Normal school day both BCTC and GMHS in-session:
 (NOTE: Please refer to your child's Skyward account for specific GMHS transportation information bus stop and bus number.)
 - Using GMSD buses, all BCTC students will depart GMHS **promptly at 7:25 a.m.**; students must arrive five minutes earlier. Students will return to GMHS at approximately 10:50 a.m. NOTE: Students who miss the bus to the career center or from the career center, must find their own transportation.
- BCTC is in-session, but GMHS has NO school (non-weather related):
 - Applies to the following dates: November 25, January 2-3, February 14, March 14, May 27-30, and June 2-3
 - On these specific days, BCTC students must find their own transportation to and from GMHS; the district will NOT provide busing.
 Using GMSD buses, all BCTC students will depart GMHS promptly at 7:25 a.m. and return at approximately 10:50 a.m.
- BCTC in-session, and GMHS is operating on a two-hour delay bell schedule: (NOTE: Students will not report to BCTC on this type of day.)

Students have two options:

- In the morning, they can arrive at the high school on their regular bus and report directly to study hall until homeroom begins at **10:35 a.m.** For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the cafeteria upon their arrival.
- Or, report directly to the high school no later than **10:30 a.m.** Students must report to homeroom which will be held in the cafeteria beginning promptly at 10:35 a.m. Students must find their own transportation; the district will **NOT** provide busing for students wishing to use this option. For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
- GMHS in-session, and BCTC has NO school or operating on a two-hour delay bell schedule: (NOTE: Students will not report to BCTC on this type of day.)

Students have two options:

- Applies to the following dates: August 19-23 and May 23
- In the morning, they can arrive at the high school on their regular bus and report directly to study hall until their classes (block 5/6) begin at **10:54 a.m.** For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the cafeteria upon their arrival.
- Or, report directly to the high school no later than 10:50 a.m., block 5/6 begins at 10:54 a.m. Students must find their own transportation; the district will NOT provide busing for students wishing to use this option. For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
- Both GMHS and BCTC have a two-hour delay: (NOTE: Students will not report to BCTC on this type of day.)

Students have two options:

- In the morning, they can arrive at the high school on their regular bus and report directly to study hall until homeroom begins at **10:35 a.m.** For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the cafeteria upon their arrival.
- Or, report directly to the high school no later than 10:30 a.m. Students must report to homeroom which will be held in the
 cafeteria beginning promptly at 10:35 a.m. Students must find their own transportation; the district will NOT provide busing for
 students wishing to use this option. For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their
 arrival.
