

SAT School Day Information



Examinees must present a Valid ID at the door – this can be a valid, non-expired drivers' license or 2023 school ID. Students who do not present an ID upon check-in at the testing room **will not** be permitted to test.

Prohibited Items

The following items are prohibited during testing unless the student has been approved for an accommodation that allows for the item:

- 
- Cell phones or smartphones;
 - Digital watches (including smartwatches, fitness trackers, or any other devices that can be used to send, receive, or record information);
 - Audio players, recorders, tablets, laptops, notebooks, or any other personal computing devices;
 - Any devices that can be used to record, transmit, receive, or play back audio, photographic images, text, or video content;
 - Cameras or any other photographic equipment;
 - Separate timers of any type;
 - Pens, highlighters, and mechanical or colored pencils;
 - Compasses, rulers, protractors, or cutting devices;
 - Books, dictionaries, or references of any kind;
 - Notes, pamphlets, or papers of any kind, including scratch paper;
 - Earplugs;
 - Drinks and snacks are allowed in the testing room but not on the desk or near testing materials.

When testing is over and you have been dismissed from the testing room, you must exit the testing hallway immediately and either go to the lunchroom or leave if you returned your Early Release form to your 1st period teacher by Friday, Oct 6. You will be permitted back on campus after 3:30 for practices or meetings.

Please remember that other students may still be testing, and we ask that you remain quiet so we can maintain an appropriate testing environment for all those testing.
