During the March 27, 2023, Special Business Meeting

The March 27, 2023 special business meeting was called to order by Treasurer Wendy Litzke. **Present:** Tricia Chasinoff, Stephen Dittmann, Samantha Jouin, and Neha Mehta. **Absent:** Jennifer Armstrong, David Barratt, Rachel Gallegos, and Andrea Rizzo. **Administrators present:** Daniel Goffredo, Charles Peterson, and Sharee McGibboney. **Others:** David Schrader, David Schipsi, and Adalise Schipsi. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Superintendent's Update

Dr. Goffredo shared that the administration is preparing to release bids for the 7-acre parcel development, the highway work associated with the 5/6 Center Project, and the General Wayne Playground Project.

Public Comment on Agenda Items

There were no public comments on agenda items.

Financial Approval

David Schrader, from SchraderGroup, presented the tentative plan for the High School Auditorium Renovations.

The base bid construction contracts for the Great Valley High School Auditorium Renovation Project were approved by a vote of 6 to 0. The following companies were awarded bids:

General Construction - Donald Reisinger – \$1,389,000
Fire Protection - Guy M Cooper – \$69,000
Mechanical Construction - Myco Mechanical – \$533,000
Electrical Construction - Schipsi Electrical – \$1,345,689

Alternate #2 to the bid of the general contractor, Donald Reisinger, to replace the auditorium seating at a cost of \$207,000 failed by a vote of 3 aye (Chasinoff, Dittmann, Litzke) to 2 nay (Jouin, Mehta).

Alternate #3 to the bid of the general contractor, Donald Reisinger, to furnish and install an acoustical shell on the auditorium stage at a cost of \$133,000 was approved by a vote of 5 to 0.

Alternate #4 to the bid of the general contractor, Donald Reisinger, to furnish and install a stage extension to the auditorium stage at a cost of \$109,000 was tabled by a vote of 5 to 0.

The awarding of the General Construction contract to demolish and replace the high school loading dock, to Donald Reisinger, at a cost of \$91,100 was approved by a vote of 5 to 0.
