AVID I - 9TH-12TH

Students will work on academic and personal goals and communication, adjusting to the high school setting. Students will increase their awareness of their personal contributions to their learning as well as their involvement in school and community. Review of AVID philosophy and strategies. No Prerequisite.

AVID II - 10TH-12TH

Refine AVID strategies to meet their independent needs and learning styles. Students will continue to refine and adjust their academic learning plans and goals, increasing awareness of their actions and behaviors. Students will expand their vocabulary use, continuing to prepare for college entrance exams. College and Career Choices. Prerequisite: Previous level

AVID III - 10TH-12TH

AVID III is the first part in a seminar course that focuses on skills expected of first-year college students. Students participate in college bound activities and confirm their post-secondary plans. Prerequisite: Previous level
