

FREQUENTLY ASKED ADMISSIONS QUESTIONS

Q. My child is currently attending a private or parochial school or is an incoming Kindergartener. What additional steps must I complete for my online application to be complete?

The state requires all students to be (pre)registered within their Resident School District.

- If your child currently attends a Delaware public school, this step is complete.
- If your child currently attends a private or parochial school, is homeschooled, or will be a new incoming Kindergartner: Please visit the statewide Public School Registration application (English, Spanish) to begin the online registration with your Resident District.

It is highly recommended that when you submit your (pre)registration with your Resident School District you tell them you will be submitting a "Choice application". This should help prioritize the registration entry into the state system.

Q. I am moving to Delaware and/or into Appoquinimink District. How do I apply and/or receive a preference for the lottery?

The State of Delaware requires applicants to be a current state resident in order to submit an application. Therefore, you cannot submit an online application until AFTER you have completed your relocation into the state. Note, this may mean you are unable to Choice for the upcoming school year. Families currently residing in Delaware who are moving into Appoquinimink District can submit an online application at any time during open enrollment. However, district preference will only be applied if the settlement for purchase is completed, or the rental agreement has a start date, on or before the third Friday of January.

In these cases, proof of new Appoquinimink District residency (copy of settlement/rental agreement) MUST be provided to MOT Charter by the last Monday of January to receive preference. Please email the required documentation to admissions@mot.k12.de.us.

Q. If I am applying for two of my children and one gets in, does the other receive a sibling preference? Are they guaranteed enrollment?

As soon as you complete the state-required First Year Agreement, and other required acceptance documents, for the child offered enrollment, other siblings will receive a *lottery* sibling preference.

Sibling applicants are NOT guaranteed enrollment. Offers of enrollment depend on open seats and current waitlist order.
