



Tuition Payments and Income Eligibility

Cristo Rey Jesuit Seattle is committed to providing an affordable Catholic education to our students. Students earn approximately 50% of the cost of their education through the Corporate Work Study program. The school requires a tuition contribution from each family. The amount of tuition is determined on a sliding scale based on annual family income. For students in the Class of 2028 (those admitted for the 2024-2025 school year) the sliding scale for tuition will range from \$400 per year (\$40 per month) to \$2,500 per year (\$250 per month).

All CRJS students must demonstrate financial need by meeting the income criteria of the Cristo Rey Network, the national organization which sets the standards for Cristo Rey schools. To be considered for admission, a family’s annual household income generally may not exceed the amount shown below in the first column for household size. A limited number of students whose income does not exceed the amount shown in the second column may also be admitted.

The parent/guardian is required to submit federal income tax returns with the student’s application for admission. Applicants will also be required to submit a current Form W-2 to verify the most recent annual income. If you do not file an income tax return or do not receive a Form W-2, please contact the admissions team to discuss alternate forms of income verification.

Upon admission, the parent/guardian will be notified of the tuition amount for the year. Tuition will be paid in ten monthly payments from August through June. Monthly tuition amounts do not include fees for athletics teams, lunch, or replacement of lost items such as textbooks, library books and PE uniforms. Should your family experience unexpected hardships which affect your ability to pay tuition, please contact the school.
