Instructions for Completing and Submitting the Golden Ticket

This fall, all seniors must make an appointment to see their college counselor. **The student must email their college counselor a completed and signed digital Golden Ticket no later than the night before the appointment.** Seattle Prep will only send transcripts, letters, etc. to schools listed on a Golden Ticket that has been signed by the student and parent. If students decide to add or subtract schools after they have submitted their initial ticket, they must email the change to their college counselor, (*cc'ing a parent on the email*).
