The 2023-2024 school year is approaching quickly! As we prepare for the first day of school on **August 28**, please reference the recommended supply list below. **Please note that there are changes to previous years, specifically that** <u>cell phones will need to be kept in lockers during the school day</u>.

Students will be required to use an assigned locker which will be located near their homeroom/advisory.

Students will be expected to bring their school issued Verizon Chromebook to and from school each day – they also need to remember to *charge* the computer each night. As a result of being awarded a grant, these Chromebooks come with a data plan for each student.

 - Hand sanitizer Each classroom is equipped with a sanitizer dispenser that will be filled each day, but if families feel comfortable sending in personal sanitizer it is an option.
 - Black marble composition book, dividers, markers, glue stick...etc.

Reminders:

- Our in-person grade 6 orientation will be 8:00 am 12:00 pm Monday, August 21 breakfast and bag lunches will be served, and bus transportation will be provided.
- The first day of school is *Monday, August 28 it is a full day.* The summer reading and math assignments will be due on that day for all students. Each student will be required to perform a book talk and show proof of completing the required task in Khan Academy. Both will count as grades in Q1.
