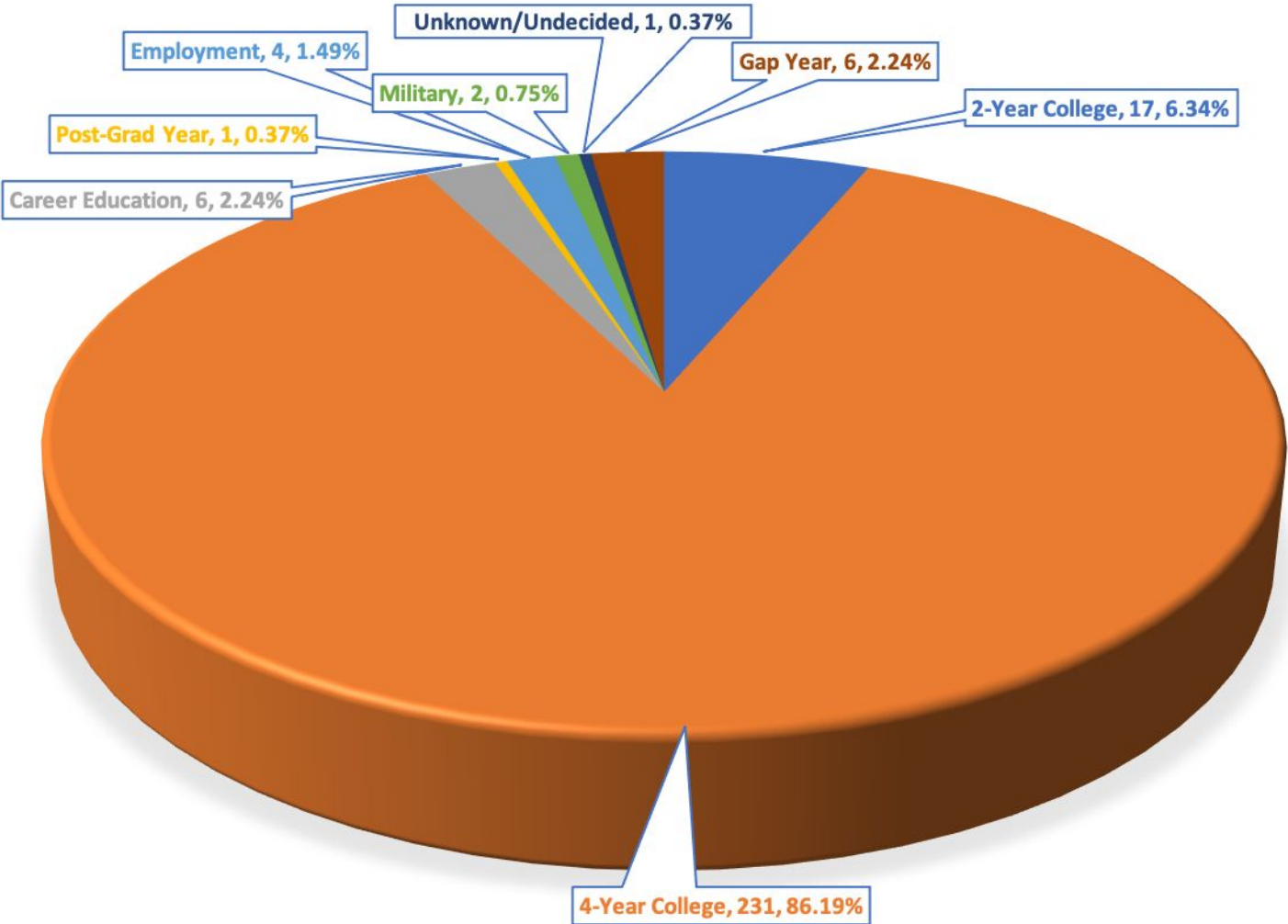

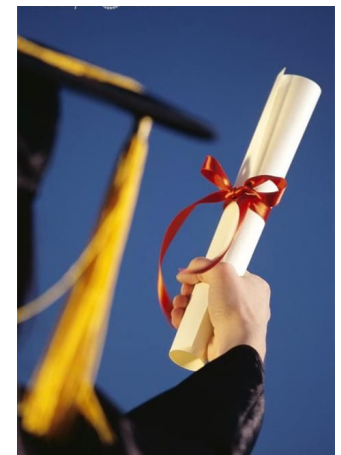
Early Decision

- Binding commitment to a first-choice institution
- 105 ED applications (including 21 EDII)
 - 15 students applied both EDI & EDII
- **36.2%** of college-going cohort applied ED
- 54 ED acceptances overall → 51.4% admit rate ED
- ED continues to play a role in maximizing admissions chances at many schools but it is a *personal, family decision*

First Generation College Students

- ❑ Defined as: “students whose parents have not earned a 4-year degree”
- ❑ $n = 56$ (~21% of class; self-reported)
- ❑ **100% of first gen students submitted at least one application**
- ❑ 401 total applications (300 acceptances)
- ❑ **92.8% pursuing higher education**

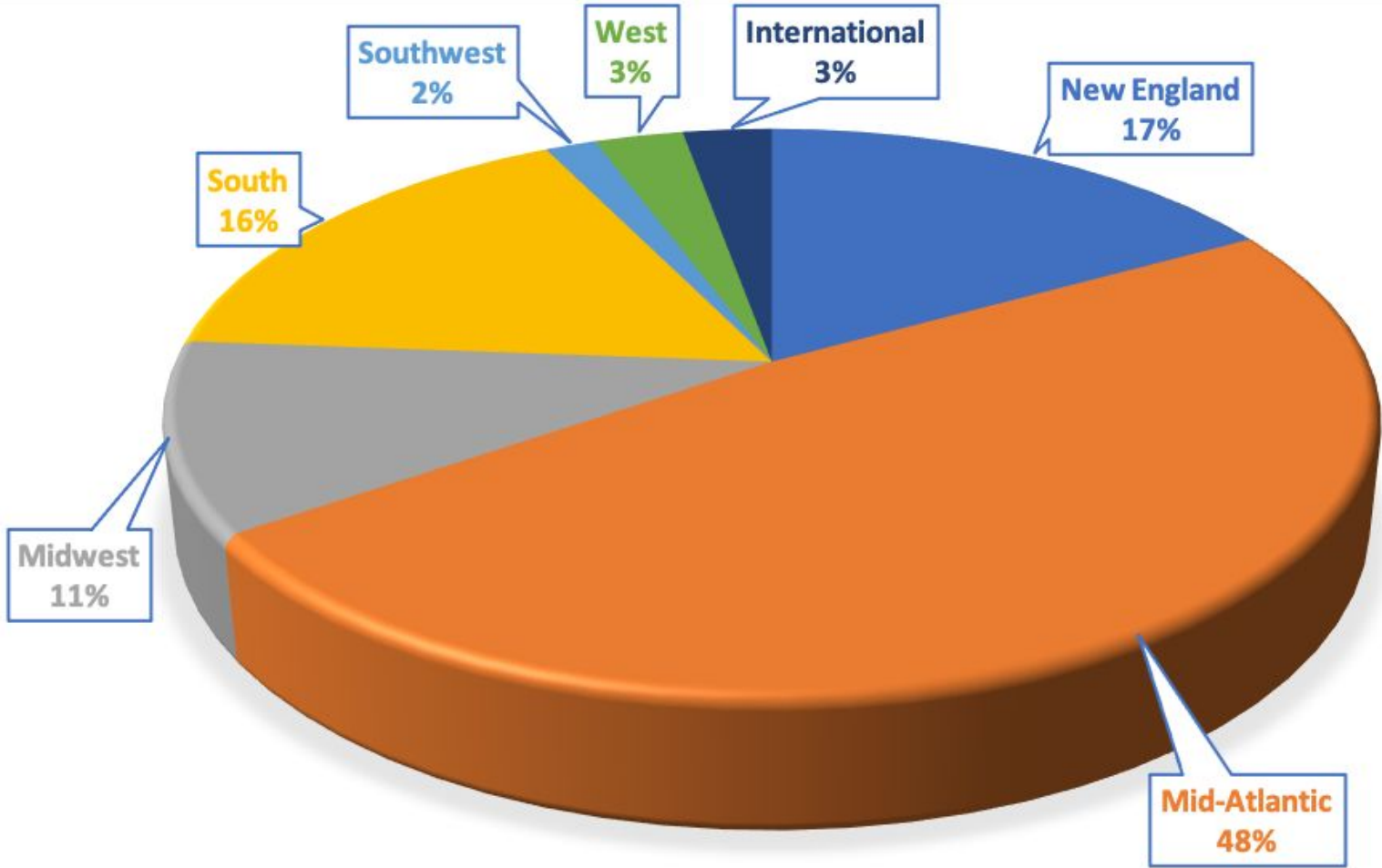
Low-Income Students

- Receive Free or Reduced lunch (as reported in Genesis)
- n = 36 (13.4% of class)*
 - *Actual number is higher
- 256 applications (198 acceptances)
- 2- and 4-year college-going rate = 80.6%
