
Dual Enrollment Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning Advanced Manufacturing

PROGRAM OF STUDY PROFILE

The Dual Enrollment HVAC program is operated in partnership with Tennessee College of Applied Technology (TCAT) of Nashville. Students will attend the Springfield Career Tech Center at Springfield High School. Students will be taught by a TCAT instructor and accumulate the same clock hours as if they were attending a TCAT institution. Furthermore, students can continue their instruction to obtain their full HVAC Technician certification after high school. During high school student can use the <u>Dual Enrollment Grant</u> to pay for their classes through this program.
