WHEREAS, the Board of Education, meeting as a Board of Canvass, examined and tabulated the statement of the results of the Annual School District election in several election districts, held on May 17, 2022. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Lia Leone received the highest number of votes and was re-elected to a three (3) year term beginning July 1, 2022 and Audre Lynn Hurst James received the second highest number of votes and is elected to a 44 day term beginning May 18, 2022 through June 30, 2022 followed by a three (3) year term beginning July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2025. Proposition I for the School District Budget passed with 751 Yes votes and 449 No votes. Proposition II for the Capital Reserve passed with 847 Yes votes and 384 No votes. Proposition III for the Student BOE Representative passed with 789 Yes votes and 435 No votes.
