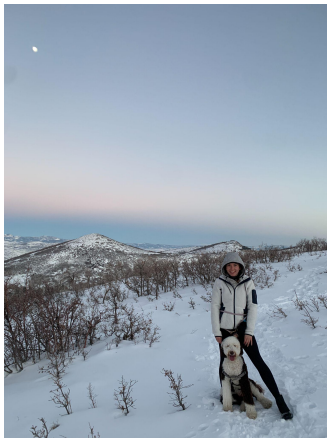
I am honored to be your teacher this year, and I am committed to making this year amazing for you and your children.
