The “Summer that never was” is rapidly coming to an end as we get prepared for students to return to the SEA. Although the unprecedented rain and subsequent flooding affected many in our school community both directly and indirectly, our building was not impacted but we did need to close down for our first week of our summer program. The flooding did appear to impact our summer attendance but we had 15 students participate regularly in the remaining 3 weeks. Despite all this, we do have many things to celebrate. At the end of the last school year, we held our Awards Ceremony, celebrating our students’ achievements including 5 highschool graduates and 2 students being accepted into CVCC in the Culinary and EMT program. Through the hard work of our Youth Employment Specialist (YES), Nashanda Browman, 10 students were enrolled in the Summer Career Exploration Program through Hireability (Voc Rehab). However, due to the flooding and other logistical challenges, several of these opportunities were not completed. Below are some highlights of our YES Program over the last two school years:

The ultimate goal of this program is to get students thinking about life after high school and the career pathway they would like to explore. We like to get students thinking beyond high school jobs and thinking about the higher wage career opportunities that are available to them.

We had a group join a three day Farm to School training at Shelburne Farms. Jen Hutchinson, BUUSD Food Programs Manager, wrote the grant for this training and to build up this program at the SEA. She is partnering with members of our faculty and students to have a food committee that will learn more about nutrition and where our food comes from as well as give input on the school menu. We will build partnerships with local farms to source much of our fresh foods and continue to build our agricultural programming. This summer we increased our garden beds and enjoyed some of the produce. We also leveled an area and began to assemble our high tunnel style greenhouse. We are looking forward to finishing that process this fall and have it ready to go for possible winter crops and early spring planting. Some other highlights that we have been working on this summer in preparation for the new school year is hiring new staff to support the Middle School Pilot Program. We will be starting with a cohort of eight 7th and 8th graders this fall. The focus will be on building relationships, social emotional learning, project based learning, and basic skill remediation in Reading, Writing, and Math to prepare these students for high school proficiencies. We will also be joining SHS for the inservice training on the 6 Seconds social emotional learning curriculum. The goal is to build a common language and common tools that will allow students and staff to work together to support student needs and build a community where all students feel that they belong and are safe.

Finally, behind the scenes, we have been working with Lauren Demers to rebuild Infinite Campus for the SEA. This will allow us to use it much more efficiently and effectively for scheduling, monitoring attendance, grading, discipline, and tracking student data. In the past we always depended on the SHS system in IC which did not fit our model at the SEA and required a lot of personnel hours and redundant systems to translate our data into the SHS system. I am also very excited to announce the rollout of our very own SEA website thanks to
