Schedules



2023-24 schedules will be available to view in Infinite Campus on Friday August 11th at 4:00 pm. Hard copy schedules will not be printed. Due to limited appointment availability for new students enrolling at Centaurus, Counselors will not be taking any appointments regarding schedule concerns or questions. Counselors will be in the Commons during lunch periods to discuss schedules with students.

A considerable amount of time and effort was put into the course selection process, creating a master schedule, and balancing class sizes. Because schedule changes create a ripple effect that impacts class size and student learning, counselors will only be changing schedules for specific academic purposes.

Valid reasons for a schedule change request include:

If a student did not get a core academic course on their schedule that was requested

If a student has not met the prerequisite to be in the current course If a student needs a course in order to meet graduation requirements If a student needs a course in order to meet college entrance requirements

The Centaurus counseling team strives to meet individual student needs and understands unique circumstances. The goals of the school to provide small class sizes and academic equity will be considered first and foremost. Students should check their schedule prior to attending

on the first day of school as class periods and teachers can change as we prioritize balanced class sizes.

Web Chromebook Distribution



Welcome back to the 2023-2024 School Year! Individual web access for students to connect to educational resources and to the world is an important component of the 1:Web Program. As a result, every 9th grade student is assigned a new 1:Web Chromebook along with any newly enrolled 5th-12th grade students.

Boulder Valley School District's 1:Web Program has been going strong in schools across the district since 2015. Please visit the 1:Web in BVSD website to see the essential components of the program: www.bvsd.org/it.

What do students need to pick up their 1:Web Chromebook?

If you do not have a current parent agreement form on file in IC you will receive an email requesting your signature before a chromebook will be assigned.

You can check in your IC account under the technology tab to see if your form has been submitted.

Program/Parent Agreement must be signed prior to student picking up their 1:Web Chromebook:

Parent Agreement - English Parent Agreement - Spanish

NOTE: If our records show that you do not have a Parent Agreement, you will get a separate email requesting an electronic signature.

9th grade students will keep their 1:Web Chromebook while enrolled in BVSD through 12th grade with an annual fee of *\$63.45. This fee will be posted to your student's account annually through 12th grade. At the end of 12th grade, BVSD will unenroll the Chromebook and it becomes the property of student.
