<u>Kindergarten Schedule Details</u>: AM Kindergarten dismissal begins at 11:45 AM. All AM K dismissals will occur from the small bus circle. If your K student will be riding the school bus, there must be an adult at the bus stop, or your child cannot be dropped off.



<u>Homeroom Assignments:</u> Families will have access to homeroom assignments via the PowerSchool Parent Portal beginning on Friday, August 25th in the early evening hours.

<u>Parent Portal/PowerSchool:</u> This is where you will access homeroom teacher assignments, transportation information about bus route/stop location/time, report cards, and also update your emergency contact information.

Arrival:

- If driving or walking, students can be dropped off at the school beginning at **8:45 AM** or 12:45 PM for PM Kindergarten. You may see students exiting buses prior to 8:45 AM; however, please do not have your children exit a car or walk to the school at that time. There is limited supervision before 8:45 AM and we want to be sure that every student is properly supervised upon arrival.
- Please review the map for details on the entrances for each grade level as well as the flow of traffic for the carline.
- If your child needs more time to exit the vehicle or needs assistance with their seat belt/car seat, please use the township parking lot and the walking path to the school.



Dismissal:

• Please inform your child's teacher of their dismissal plan. Establish a consistent dismissal plan for your child. This is best for your child and the classroom environment.

Carline Reminders:

- Parents will enter the school campus from Righters Mill Road and proceed to the small bus loop near the K/1 entrance for drop-off and pick-up.
- Please do not get out of your vehicle.

- During arrival children should be ready to unload on the right-hand side of your vehicle when you pull up. During dismissal as your vehicle approaches the pick-up location, staff will radio for your child(ren) to exit the building. Please continue to pull your car forward in the circle so that students can enter the car towards the end of the circle.
- All students will receive a carline pick up card on the first day of school.

Student Pick up/Walkers Reminders:

• Families may pick up from the main entrance as well. Be sure to bring a paper with your child(ren)'s names and teacher on it.

Bus Transportation:

• Your child's bus number and pick up/drop off information will be available for families to view on the Parent Portal on Friday, August 25th in the early evening hours.

Lunch/Recess for Grades 1-4:

- Breakfast will continue to be free for all students during the 23-24 school year.
- Lunch, and snacks are available for purchase in the school cafeteria. Money can be added to your child's account by using this site.

Snack:

• Please pack a snack for your child daily.

<u>Electronic Devices - iPads (Grades K/1) and Chromebooks (Grades 2-4):</u>

- All students will be provided an electronic device to use throughout the school year; however, families must complete the Acceptable Use Policy form (AUP) on the Parent Portal so that students can use technology at school.
- All electronic devices will remain at school.
