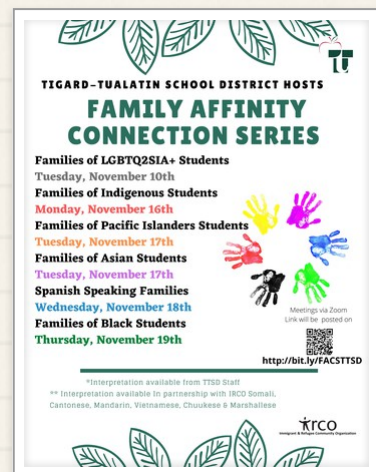

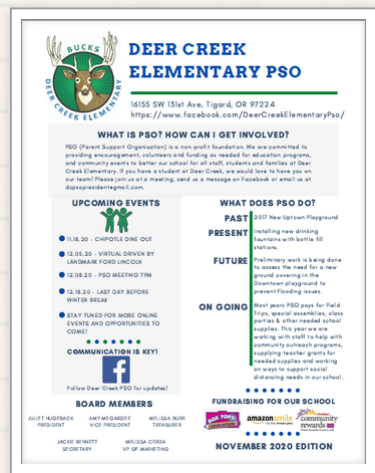

Students can earn a free book for every two hours of volunteer reading.



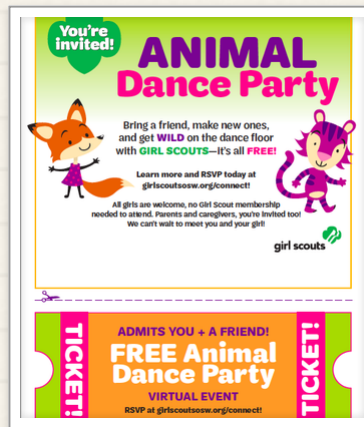
