Supply Pick Up Day

Hello Deer Creek Families,

I hope this finds you healthy, safe, and in a routine with school starting. Now that school has started there are a few items we would like our students to have at home. We are scheduling a supply pick up day for Wednesday, September 30th. **If you have a 4th grade student, you only need to come if you were unable to pick up supplies on the 23rd.** The schedule is as follows:

Grade Level Times:

Kinder & 1st - 2:00 – 3:00

2nd & 3rd - 3:00 – 4:00

4th & 5th - 4:00 – 5:00 (Only 4th grade students who weren't able to come September 23rd)

5:00 – 6:00 (This time is only for parents who can't come during their specified time)

We ask that you please try to come during your scheduled time as this will help keep the congestion down.

The process to pick up materials will be to drive up along the curb and stop by the main entrance. You will need to present a piece of paper with your student's first/last name and teacher. A staff member will retrieve the items and bring them to you. If your family has students in multiple grades you will be able to pick all of them up at one time.

Espero que esto lo encuentre saludable, seguro y en una rutina con el comienzo de la escuela. Ahora que la escuela ha comenzado, hay algunos artículos que nos gustaría que los estudiantes tuvieran en casa. Estamos programando un día de recogida de suministros para el **miércoles 30 de septiembre**. Si usted tiene un estudiante de 4to grado solo tiene que venir si usted no pudo recoger suministros en el 23. El horario es el siguiente:

Tiempos de nivel de grado:

Kinder y 1er 2:00 – 3:00

2do & 3er 3:00 – 4:00

4to & 5to 4:00 – 5:00 (solo tiene que venir si usted no pudo recoger suministros en el 23)

5:00 - 6:00 (este horario es solo para los padres que no pueden venir durante el horario especificado)

Le pedimos que intente venir durante el horario programado, ya que esto ayudará a reducir el trafico.

El proceso para recoger materiales será manejar hasta la entrada principal. Deberá presentar una hoja de papel con el nombre / apellido y el maestro de su estudiante. Un miembro del personal le traerá los artículos. Si su familia tiene estudiantes en varios grados, podrá recogerlos todos al mismo tiempo.

- What is something you can do now that you couldn't do last year/month/week?

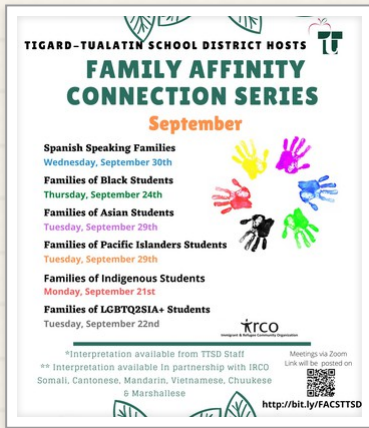
