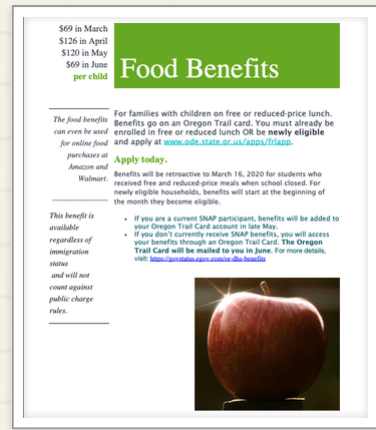
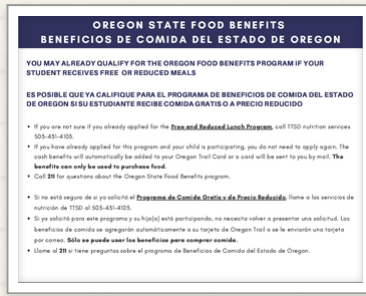

TIGARD-TUALATIN Schools to Expand Meal Sites

Tigard-Tualatin School District will begin providing free meals at 10 additional sites throughout Tigard and Tualatin communities beginning **Monday, April 27, 2020**. These sites are in addition to the ongoing meal service at both Metzger Elementary School in Tigard and Tualatin Elementary School in Tualatin. Breakfast and lunch will be provided in one grab-and-go container for youth ages 1 to 18 Monday through Friday. There will be designated areas for meal pick-up at each of the listed complexes. All local-area youth are welcome to participate at these sites and parents can pick-up meals for their children. Social distancing measures will be required and practiced at each location. Meal deliveries will continue through June 11, 2020 or until further notice. There will be no meal delivery on Memorial Day, Monday, May 25, 2020.

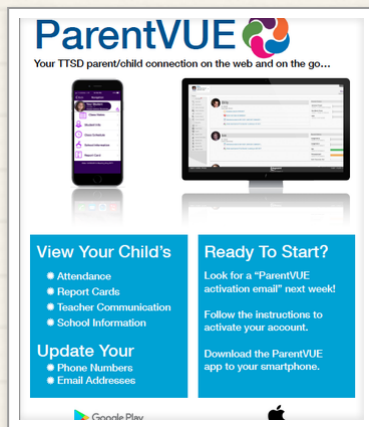
ParentVue

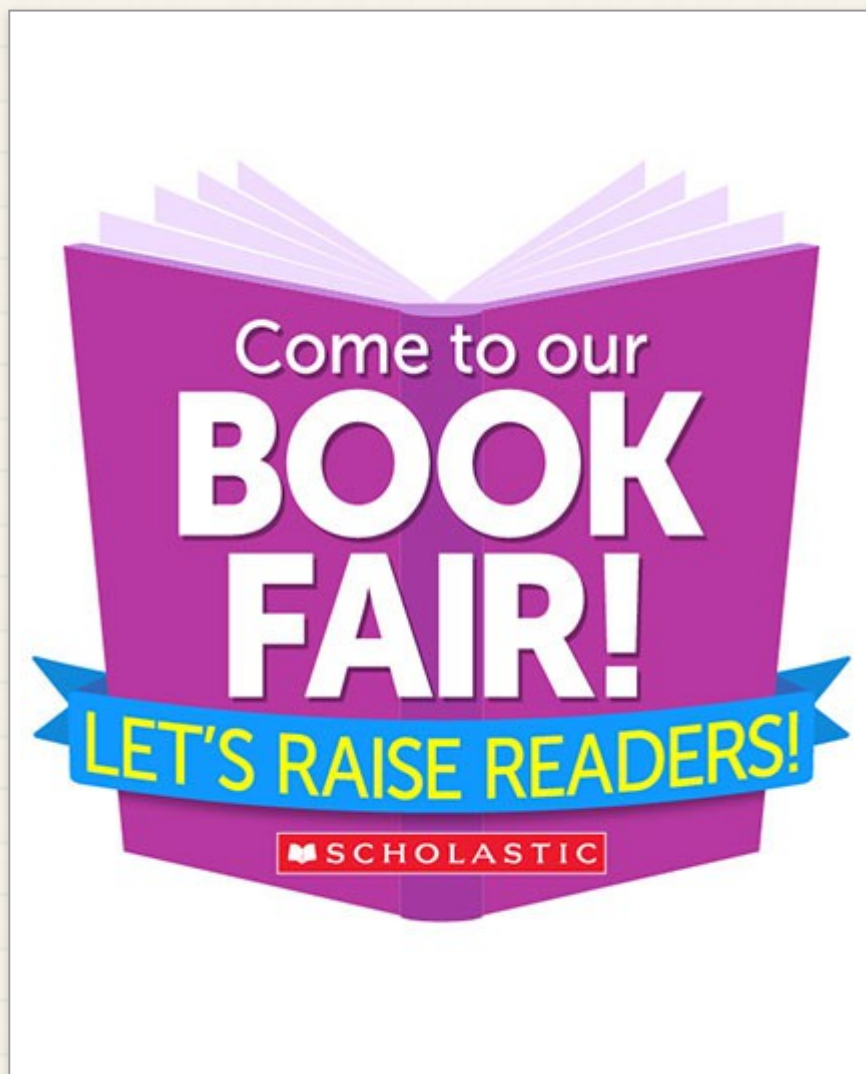


