SCHOOL INFORMATION

PICK UP LINE START TIME

STARTING THE PICK UP LINE TOO EARLY IS CAUSING AGGRESSIVE DRIVING AND CONCERNS FROM THE POLICE.

- Kinder and 1st grade family cars may enter the parking lot **starting at 2:10pm.**
- 2nd-5th grade family cars may enter the lot **starting at 2:15pm.**
- **Please DO NOT begin the pick-up line before 2:10pm.** Arriving before this pick-up window causes heavy area congestion (in most cases, area gridlock) causing various safety concerns. **Entering a line that is beginning to move is better than entering a line that won't be moving for 30+ minutes.**
- Please help us be efficient by staying in your car and quickly leaving the lot once your child is in the car.

This system is designed to be a quick drive through. If you need to help your child with their seatbelt, please pull into a parking spot.

NUTRITION SERVICES UPDATE

The universal free meals waiver with USDA has expired. Beginning the 2022-2023 school year meals will be charged to the student accounts.

Please set up your student's meal account or apply for free meals through the [Titan Program Website](#). Everyone should fill out the free and reduced lunch application, even if you are not sure if you qualify. TTSD is no longer using the My School Bucks Program. All funds that were in your student's account with Myschoolbucks have been carried over and will be accessed through Titan.

Please set up a student meal account with [Titan](#) to pay for your students school meals or drop a check off at the school office.

- **Alert emails are being sent to families regarding negative meal account balances. All meals received by a student will be charged to their account.**
- Your student can qualify for free meals if your family household income falls below the amounts outlined in the [Oregon Expanded Income Guidelines](#).
- Example, a family of four with a combined household income of less than \$83,250 would qualify for free meals.

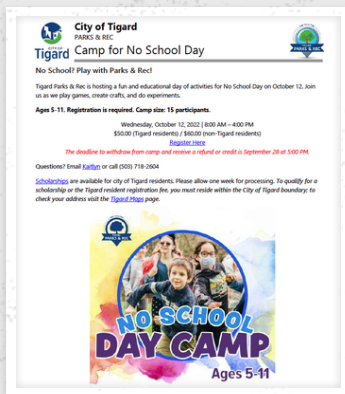

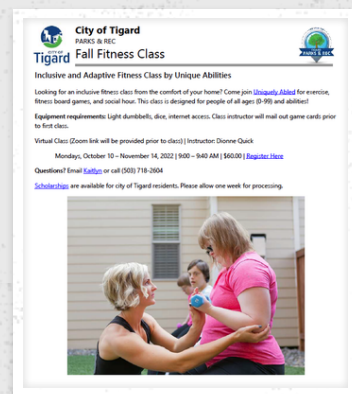
