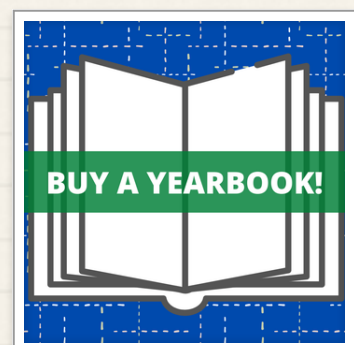

**Drowning is Preventable**  
It can happen in seconds and is often silent

Drowning is the second leading cause of unintentional injury death for children ages 1 to 14 years, and the fifth leading cause for people of all ages. More children ages 1-4 die from drowning than any other cause of death except birth defects.\*

**5 things you can do to prevent drowning:**

1. Assign an adult to consistently watch children around water. Stay in areas reach and do not get distracted.
2. Learn to float. Learn basic swimming skills. Never swim alone.
3. Wear a US Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Device (PFD) (life vest/throw pillow) and avoid open water, jet docks, and jet boats. Some PFDs come with an auto-inflate feature. If your device is inflatable, consider having one and attaching it to the life vest.
4. Back away from water. Encourage multiple barriers are in place around backyard pools.
5. Learn CPR with rescue breaths.

**Rip currents are powerful, narrow channels of water moving in the offshore direction. They can occur along any coastline with breaking waves, and are present along most U.S. coastlines. A rip current pulls swimmers away from the shore into deeper water; it does not pull you under - paddling and trying to swim against the rip currents is what will pull you under. Rip currents account for over 80% of rescues performed by surf beach lifeguards. The United States Lifeguard Association estimates that more than 500 people die each year due to rip currents on our nation's beaches.**

**What do you do if you are ever caught in water above your head?**

**HEP, FLOUT, and HOLD!**

The most important thing to remember when drowning is to stay calm, paddling will exhaust you the fastest.

1. HEP - keep your head above water, calm yourself, and conserve energy. Floating is the most important swimming skill to know.
2. FLOUT - to keep your head above water, calm yourself, and conserve energy. Floating is the most important swimming skill to know.
3. HOLD - to keep your head above water, calm yourself, and conserve energy. Floating is the most important swimming skill to know.

HEP, FLOUT, and HOLD! will be more useful and more effective if you are wearing a US Coast Guard approved PFD. Wearing brightly colored equipment and PFDs will also make it easier for you to be seen by rescuers.

Water wings, pool noodles, and inflatable toys, not safety devices. Do not rely on them to keep your child safe in the water.

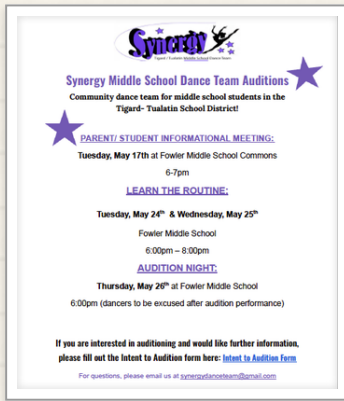

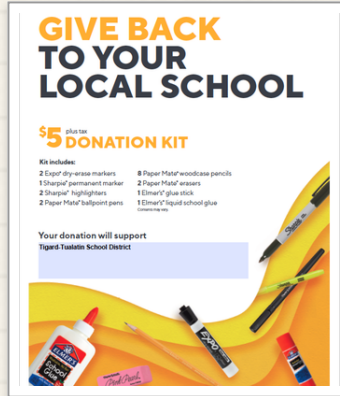
