Masks at School

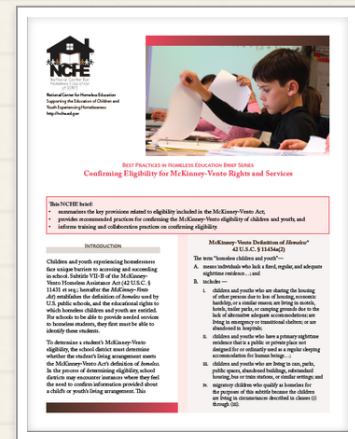
to complete the enrollment.

Online Silent Auction

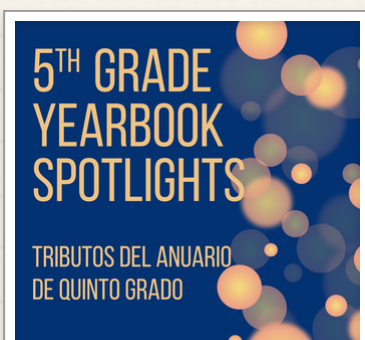
