Kindergarten Registration

Monday, January 31, the TTSD online kindergarten registration portal opened for the 2022-23 school year.

In order to enroll your child for kindergarten they **MUST be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2022**. Parents/Guardians will need their child's birth certificate, proof of address (rental agreement/mortgage document, utility bill or property tax statement) and immunization record to complete the enrollment.

K-12 COVID Screening Program

For those students who are participating, we will collect spit tests on Tuesday, February 22 instead of Monday, February 21 due to the holiday.

With the omicron variant surging, we are seeing more students testing positive for COVID.

Those students who test positive should not participate in our program for 90 days after receiving their results, as they will continue to test positive during this time period. These repeat positive tests consume testing supplies and staff time, and distract us from helping students who are healthy or are just being diagnosed with COVID for the first time. Students with a positive result **do not** need to opt-out of the program, but they **do** need to pause their participation until the 90-day period has ended.

Drop Off and Pick Up Reminder

Morning Drop Off

We are not able to let children into the building before 7:45am. Please try to arrive at school between 7:45am and 8:00am. Arriving before this time creates a backup onto 131st Ave.

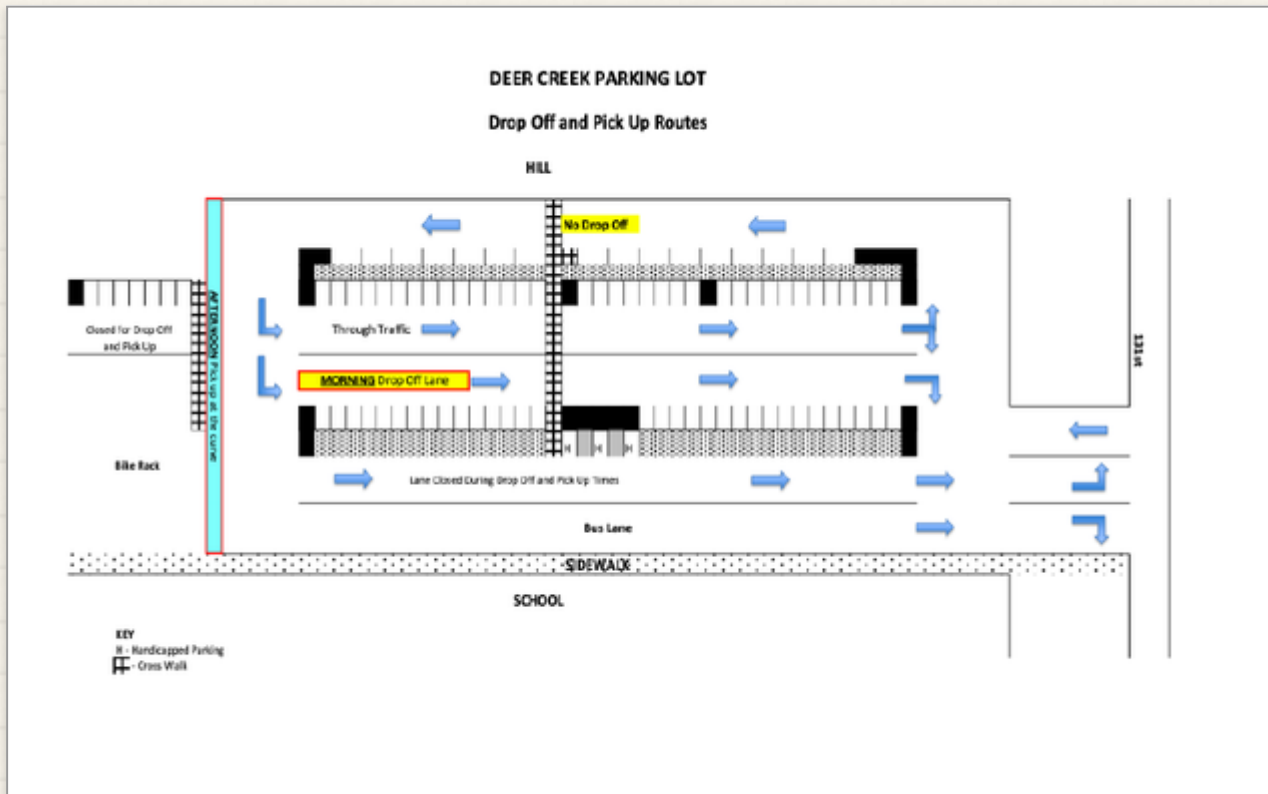
Afternoon Pick-Up Pull Through

- Kinder and 1st grade will release at 2:15. 2nd-5th grade will release at 2:20pm.
- Kinder and 1st grade family cars may enter the parking lot starting at 2:10pm and 2nd-5th grade family cars may enter the lot starting at 2:15pm.
- Please DO NOT begin the pick-up line before 2:10pm. Arriving before this pick-up window causes heavy area congestion (in most cases, area gridlock) causing various safety concerns. Entering a line that is beginning to move is better than entering a line that won't be moving for 30+ minutes.
- Please help us be efficient by staying in your car and quickly leaving the lot once your child is in the car.

This system is designed to be a quick drive through. If you need to help your child with their seatbelt, please pull into a parking spot.

Walkers

If you're meeting your child to walk home, you may meet them at the bike racks closest to your walking path. This means you may meet your child at the bike rack on 131st OR the bike rack near the covered play area.

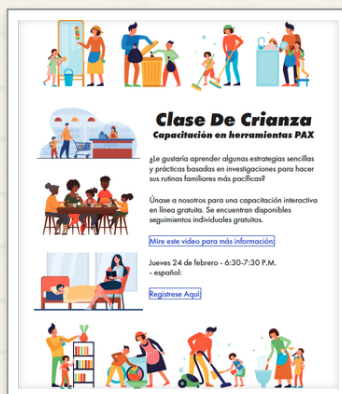

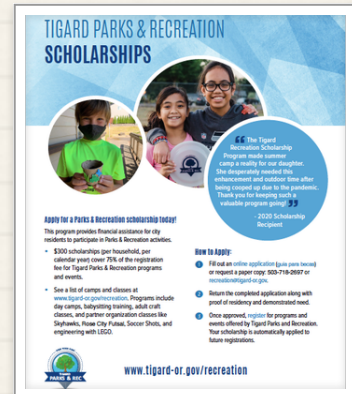
